## **Sources in Shipley Local Studies relating to Shipley**

Shipley township, three miles north west of Bradford, was in the parish of Bradford and wapentake of Morley. It included Moorhead, Shipley Fields and parts of Heaton Rord and Frizinghall, while Saltaire was built within its boundaries. A Local Board of Health was established in 1853, and an Urban District in 1894. Windhill and Wrose were transferred to Shipley from Idle in 1891. In 1974 Shipley became part of Bradford Metropolitan District.

In Shipley library, the map cabinets in the library store a range of historical maps and there is a comprehensive collection of images of Shipley available for consultation. There is also an extensive range of books, news cuttings, articles, journals and other material stored in Shipley library. What you see on the shelves in Shipley library is only a selection of the stock. Most of the collection is stored in an archive stack. The main Local Studies Library in Bradford has an extensive range of sources of information dealing with Shipley.
