The following change is to be made to the Bradford North Proposals Map: • Amend the centre and retail area boundaries of the Thornbury District Centre as defined on the Proposals Map to include the car parking and service areas of the Morrisons and B&Q stores, the Woodhall Retail Centre and the car park areas to the north of the former Halfords store, as shown on map (mod ref MOD/BN/C/2).	Wm. Morrison Supermarkets Plc objected to the Plan. They said that defined boundaries of the district centres shown on the Proposals Map excluded the car parks associated with large foodstores and that these were integral to the shops and services available within the defined centres. They considered the car parking areas should be included within the boundaries of the centres. Their objection was recorded against paragraph 7.57 of the Policy Framework of the UDP. Later, by way of letter dated 7 August 2003 to the programme officer, they made it clear that their objection related only to the Mayo Avenue and Thornbury District Centres. The Inspector concluded (para 7.23 of his report on objections to the Policy Framework) that where a car park is integral part of a centre and required for its efficient operation then it should be included in the boundary. Elsewhere in his report where similar objections to the boundaries of certain local centres are considered, the Inspector stated that the service areas of such stores should also be included. Whilst the Inspector made no specific recommendation arising from this objection it is clear from his conclusion that he accepted the objector's argument. Consequently the boundary of the Thornbury District Centre, and the retail area within it defined for the purposes of policy CR1a is to be modified in line with the Inspector's conclusion.
