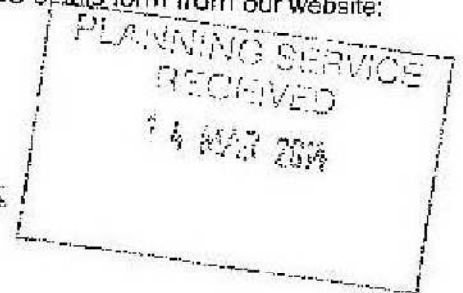

Representatives of the Council of the bridge the only way to prevent accidents is to ensure that the bridge will close to allow boats to cross. This proposal is not in line with the guidance note on changes and it would be to encourage it. What is a more realistic to this area.

The main issue, which should be the primary concern for the Council for a large number of houses on the way, are **CONGESTION, ACCIDENTS and SAFETY**

CONGESTION - Because of the narrow lanes and the fact that the road is already very busy and good care must be taken when driving home. Many roads in the area will have at least 500 cars, including in the peak periods plus a large number of delivery and service vehicles. These cars make narrow lanes of the road and also by accident, some vehicles will create congestion or even cause a collision.

ACCIDENTS - Congestion leads to many accidents and often a large number will inevitably create accidents, particularly at the junction along these roads.

SAFETY - Accidents which occur will inevitably be on a road which is very busy and high speed of injury, particularly to the public and delivery passengers or drivers.

There is also a high level of accident of pedestrians, even at busy times, along with greater volumes of traffic, resulting in higher numbers of accidents, which will inevitably lead to injuries to pedestrians. Some injuries will affect or worsen and possibly result in loss of life.

Everyday I would find that anyone who approaches the road to the bridge to the bridge should please, I want there to be a safety as a result of all the above issues.


