1. SHLAA is inadequate to meet assessed housing need and no evidence to suggest co-operation with neighbouring authorities to resolve the lack of housing land within Bradford District
2. Housing need primarily arises within the identified "City of Bradford including Shipley and Lower Baildon" sub-area yet provision does not match this need seeming more likely to meet housing demand from Leeds, North Yorkshire and Calderdale
3. Sites within the "City of Bradford including Shipley and Lower Baildon" especially in the inner city are not viable even given the provision in ID2 for viability assessments
4. No mechanism or plans are identified to facilitate the desire to regenerate inner suburbs for example by providing for the application of Community Infrastructure Levy or New Homes Bonus to regeneration
