Impact on principal town status for Ilkley.

Part of Wharfedale is impacted by the HRA Special Protection Area on the moors above Middleton. These are shown on Fig 6.1 but not referred to in the text. That SPA is in North Yorkshire but the mitigation zone adjoins the Rombald's Moor SPA mitigation zone. The impact is that the whole of Ilkley is placed in the 2.5 km zone.

The valley itself is a wildlife corridor. Birds tend to migrate up and down the valley as well as from moor to moor across the valley.

The Nidderdale AONB and the Yorkshire Dales National Park should both be consulted with regard to development plans for Wharfedale before any Local Plan targets to build houses/infrastructure in Burley in Wharfedale, Addingham and Ilkley are agreed. I cannot see any evidence of this in the draft core strategy or the HRA document. Para 7.6.1 of the HRA does not confirm if there has been any consultation. Para 7.7 is unclear – double negatives obscure the sense. At 8.43, the consultees should additionally include North Yorkshire CC, Nidderdale AONB, the Yorkshire Dales National Park and local groups which hold historical and up-to-date data on species eg Wharfedale Naturalists and Bradford Ornithological Group on both areas of SPA and Wharfedale.

Ilkley should be a local service centre with very little growth planned for the next 15 years, because there is so little space available for development other than windfall sites.
