The Plan does not meet objectively assessed infrastructure requirements necessary for sustainable development. Schools are over subscribed and children are already bussed in and out of the town; GP services are full and have limited parking available; the A65 is already congested and a bottle neck; peak time public transport cannot cope; roads and car parks are insufficient for further vehicle use. Limited local employment opportunities will mean commuting to work outside the valley would be a necessity.
