North Yorkshire County Council supports Bradford Council's intention under Policy ID4 *Working with Partners* to work with neighbouring authorities to ensure that requirements for new infrastructure and services can be met. We also support the targeting of infrastructure priorities for development in Airedale through Policy AD2 *Investment Priorities for Airedale*.

Silsden, Steeton and Eastburn are served by South Craven secondary school at Cross Hills, near Keighley, in North Yorkshire.

The Local Plan proposes to allocate 1,700 houses in Silsden and Steeton and Eastburn. These would generate approximately 221 secondary-aged pupils. As South Craven school is forecast to reach its capacity over the next 10 years, there will be a requirement for up to 7 additional classrooms from these housing developments which the County Council would expect to secure through S106 agreements or other funding, and it would therefore need to be consulted as a statutory consultee on any housing applications in the Silsden and Steeton and Eastburn areas.
