The council will negotiate for up to the following proportions of affordable housing on residential developments:

- Up to 30% in Wharfedale
- Up to 25% elsewhere

Affordable housing should be provided on-site and be indistinguishable from and well integrated with market housing, unless off-site provision or a financial contribution can be robustly justified and would support the creation of inclusive and mixed communities.

This amendment gives the Council the right to expect developers to provide the sort of housing that the district requires.
