Dear Sir/Madam

As a Baildon resident for the last 12 years, I strongly object to LDF proposals to build 450 new homes for Baildon, many, if not all of them on the present fields adjacent to the present former reservoir location.

Already having a population greater than that of Shipley or Ilkley or Skipton, Baildon has the facilities of a small village like Gargrave or Grassington. To drive to work from Baildon is becoming impossible. In the morning, the traffic down Baildon road towards Shipley is so congested that it is faster to walk. Frustrated motorists are increasingly trying to negotiate the dangerously narrow Spring Lane to Eldwick and the equally hazardous and narrow road through Sconce towards Hawksworth.

Baildon Hill and Moor is a rare green space amenity close to the centre of Bradford and, as such, accessible to, and well used for recreation by, all in the community. Filling the hillside with housing spoils this amenity.
