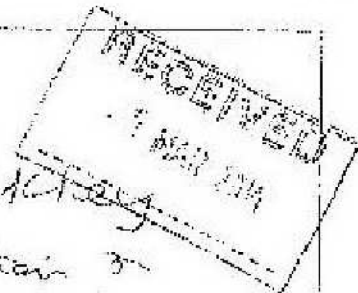

If so many more houses were built this would exacerbate this problem. Trolley Green Centre is often a bottleneck now. A70

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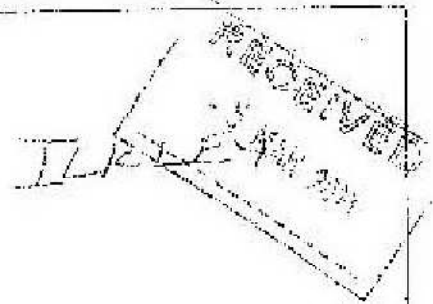
Parking in the town is already

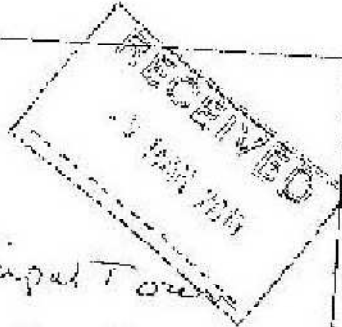
