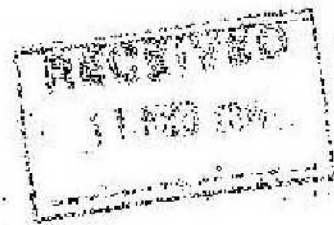

Plans for 800 houses in UKLE7

Comment:

There appears to be no apparent rationale for the above numbers of houses to be built in UKLE7. I believe that the council did not have all the information needed when required to vote on the plan. UKLE7 is not, as indicated in the plan, a "Primary Team" like Keighley (the fact that it currently has a town hall is non-central, and the town hall is due, I believe, to be closed as part of cost savings. UKLE7 is a spa town, festival town - a tourist attraction, which should be maintained to encourage people to bring spending...

into the area's economy. The local roads, especially A65
cannot sustain/accommodate an increase in traffic
that 600 new houses would bring. The local health
services - GP practices, and schools do not
have capacity for the extra numbers of people
who would require these services. The houses would
likely be built as 'ribbon development', thus leading
to a loss of a clear town identity - see township
comments. Negative impact on local zones of influence.
Feasibility of affordable housing questionable given local
land values being so high. No apparent intention
to build on 'brown field' first. Overall this does not make
sense to do.
