2. young children. I know that school places are already full with some children being bused away to schools in other towns. The road infrastructure (ABS) already backs up 2 miles either side of Ilkley on busy days, whilst other services (water, drainage, health provision) are at full stretch.

3. There is no space to build further on Green Belt land which should be protected for development as per the stipulations of national Government. It is for the above reasons that I wholeheartedly object to the planned development in the Ilkley area.
