Due to no progress being made in connection with the A65 Ilkley/Wharfedale Bypass the new 800 homes would greatly extend the current problems resulting in total grid lock on the A65 Leeds Road.

There would be insufficient medical provisions for an additional 800 homes as the population would be increased by approximately 30%.

There would not be enough parking provision for an estimated further 2000 cars.
