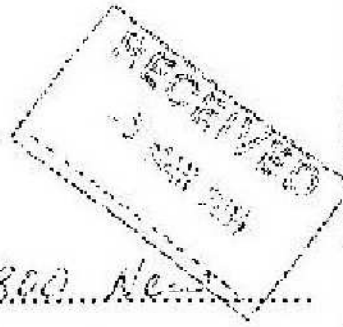

Proposed Building of 800 New Houses in Ilkley

Whilst it is agreed that more houses need to be built around the country the actual amount of 800 for Ilkley is rather excessive, bearing in mind the following points:-

- 1. Roads through (A65) already congested.
- 2. Schools already full and not sufficient for present population, impact of 800 family houses will cause great problems in this regard.
- 3. This also applies to medical/dental facilities.
- 4. Parking is already a major problem in Ilkley, which has not been addressed for many years. The possibility of 1200 extra cars coming with family houses would create severe problems.
- 5. The station also would be under pressure -- again lack of parking for commuters.
- 6. Some possible sites put forward for housing would have environmental impact as they already have problems with drainage and more roads etc. will exacerbate this.
