Dear Sir

I object to Bradford Metropolitan District Council's Core Strategy on the grounds that the Aire/Wharfe valley regions of the district cannot support more housing without infringement of its green belt and green fields.

Housing development that has already occurred in the above identified area, since the second World War has taken place with a serious neglect of commensurate infrastructure improvement.

As a nation, we still rely heavily on the sewage system that was installed by our Victorian ancestors. Were they so forward thinking as to anticipate and build a system that would adequately accommodate a population increase of the magnitude that has occurred? I think not.
