Schools in Ilkley are already full to capacity. Should the specified number of new homes materialise there is no provision made for the accommodation of more candidates for school places.

The need to provide more spaces at both primary and secondary level is recognised both by Bradford Council and School Governors throughout the valley. The suggested place for a new Secondary school to replace Ilkley grammar School now appears to be designated as a preferred housing site. No other site has become apparent.

At present the 'sixth forms' of IGS are only open to students with 5 or more B grade GCSEs. There is no vocational training available in Ilkley and there will soon be the 16 - 18 year olds who are invited to stay on for further education to be catered for. Where?

Almost all of the available recreational land formerly linked to educational establishments has already been built on or is scheduled for housing development. This will produce further pressure to find space for the greater numbers requiring such space for sport and other activities.

It would not be ideal to further load the transport system and congested roads with students travelling further afield for their education.
