Dear Sirs.


I have just spend a significant amount of time trying to see the plans under the Local Development Scheme, July 2005 etc and it is proving impossible to find the documents to view. However, I am informed that the plan includes development proposals for Heights Lane, Eldwick and I would wish to register my objections to this on the basis of safety and access.

When travelling up Heights Lane from Eldwick towards East Morton there has already been a development to the right hand side, Dalesway and Pengarth, with green belt land to the left hand side which I understand is considered under this LDF proposals.

My objections would be due the the narrowness of Heights Lane and the precedent of the Dalesway Pengarth development being denied access to Heights Lane due to this. There is Eldwick Riding Club, which frequently uses Heights Lane for access and this would, in my view, lend significant safety concerns should any development be permitted to access Height Lane. It is clearly unsafe on a national speed limited road to even consider this course of action.

I appreciate there is a deadline of 17:00 hours today, 31st March 2014, to formally object and I would very much appreciate this being accepted as such or if not then guidance on how I can register my objections in time please?
