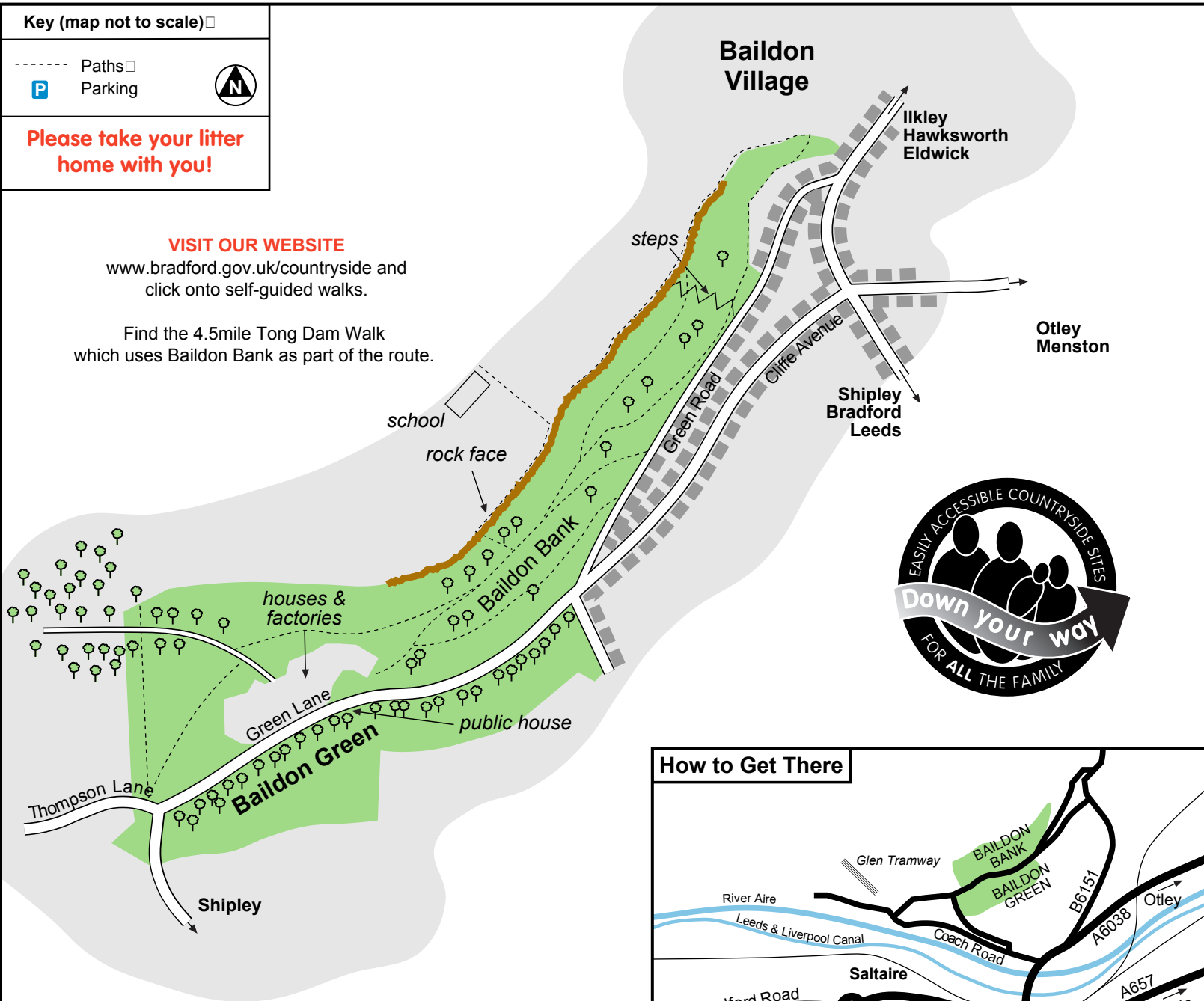

How to Get There



Baildon Bank & Baildon Green

One of a series of easily accessible countryside sites within the Bradford Metropolitan District.

64 acres (26 hectares) of grassland, including a south facing wooded hillside and an extensive length of high, exposed rock face along a narrow high level grassy plateau.

Ideal 'Walking for Health' site.

Due to the very nature of the countryside this hilly site may cause problems for the less mobile and pushchairs. The site is not suitable for wheelchair users. There are no gates or stiles on this site, there is however, a steep flight of steps to the north eastern end.

The former quarry area has a large expanse of high, exposed rock face. Please take care when walking nearby. Climbing the rock face is only suitable for experienced climbers.

Children should be under close supervision at all times.
