Date	Incident	Action
Early 2015	Repeated damage to trim trail out of school hours – repeated digging up of wet pour material necessitating a complete removal and replacement in June/July 2015	Replacement of wet pour area on trim trail
May-June 2015	Damage to school field – access by children out of hours causing repeated damage to school field – goal mouth area out of bounds	Required removal of goal posts to deter use of field out of school hours – four areas had to be filled and re-seeded.
June 2015	Children using school property to access neighbouring allotments after school hours – complaints from allotment holder re breaks in and theft by youths	
June 2015	Broken beer bottles found on the school playground – bottles thrown onto the roof of the playground shelters	
June 2015	Children spotted on the school roof	Staff member challenged the children and requested them to come down off the roof
June-July 15	Repeated incidents of drug paraphernalia on school premises – empty bags used for drugs, rolling papers, empty lighters	Site manager requested to do regular morning checks for drug paraphernalia – discussed with PCSO – to include school in regular checks
14.9.15	Site manager discovered empty bottles of alcohol outside Y1	Discussed with PSCO when visited school. Said he would increase patrols.
21.9.15	Site manager discovered drug paraphernalia on school site	Photographed, shared with police
3.10.15	Damage to outside table by Year 1 – offensive comments and pictures	Turned over top of table, gain quotes for putting shutters doors on the canopy
15.10.15	Complaint from allotment holder about football smashing panes of glass in greenhouse	Staff spoke to allotment holder, apologised on behalf of school
17.10.15	Member of staff removed dog faeces from field	
12.11.15	Site manager removed dog faeces from field	
7.12.15	Site manager removed litter and empty alcohol bottles from outside Y1 classroom after weekend	
18.1.16	Complaint from allotment holder about footballs being kicked over hedge over the weekend and people jumping over hedge to retrieve balls damaging planting	Advised to contact police
25.1.16	Site manager removed empty alcohol cans from outside Y1 following weekend	
22.2.16	Site manager discovered attempted fire outside Y1 empty alcohol cans and bottles	
9.3.16	Dog wandering round school site all morning	Phoned dog warden who removed dog
28.4.16	Evidence of drug taking and empty alcohol containers – crime number 13160181367	
May 2016	Shutter doors put on Year 1 canopy	
June-July 16	Trees planted on perimeter by children – ripped out on date/dates unknown	
June 2016	School benches removed from site	Benches had to be retrieved by staff, from various locations in the village

10.8.16 Email from PCSO Darrin Thompson	On Monday evening I have been around the school and moved some youths on site, I have picked up a cover for one of the CCTV cameras, I knocked on Brendan's door but there was no answer. I have the cover in my locker at the Police Station for safe keeping.	Evidence from CCTV – youths had been on roof and pulled at CCTV covers to break them. Not able to identify them on CCTV
25.9.16 Email from parent	I just wanted to let you know that there were a group of youths on the school premises today and as well as climbing onto, then jumping off, the school roof, they were also smoking and using offence language when young children were playing. There were 3 girls and 4 boys, who all looked about 12/13yrs old. I know that you obviously can't monitor every individuals behaviour who is on the premises out of school hours, but I thought you should be aware of what occurred due to the fact that a serious incident could have easily arisen, if one of them had landed badly.	26.9.16 PCSO visited school to view CCTV footage
