Explanatory Notes on Rights of Way Section Information

CON 29 Question 2.2

The information on public rights of way available from this site is not the Definitive Map, it is an interpretation of the Definitive Maps for the area and other records. We aim to provide an up to date record of routes which are recorded on either the Definitive Maps or other records.

Routes shown in the layer 'TLC Q2.2 Public Paths' are derived from the 1:10,560 scale Modified Definitive Map for the West Yorkshire County Council area.

Routes shown in the layer 'TLC Q2.2 Non Definitive Paths' are also within the part of the district covered by the Modified Definitive Map. These routes are not recorded on this Modified Definitive Map but are derived from additional records.

Routes shown in the layer 'TLC Q2.2 Bradford Paths' are in the area of the former County Borough of Bradford. The former County Borough did not adopt Part IV of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and so did not prepare a Definitive Map for the County Borough Area. In more recent years City of Bradford MDC has commenced work on a Definitive Map for this area. The routes shown are an interpretation of various relevant records including the Bradford Definitive Map.

All of these layers are accompanied by a 5 metre buffer layer as some of the paths are derived from maps at 1:10,560 scale.

The information shown is without prejudice to the possibility that unrecorded rights may exist of which the Council is unaware.

CON 29 Question 2.3

The layer '**TLC Q.2.3 DMMO applications**' can be used to answer Question 2.3 on the revised CON29. It shows applications currently recorded on the Register prepared and published under the *Public Rights of Way (Register of Applications under Section 53(5) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981) (England) Regulations 2005. A copy of the plan submitted with the application can be obtained by clicking on the route and using the hyperlink next to the word Plan in the pop up information.*

CON 29 Question 2.4

The layer '**TLC Q2.4 path orders**' can be used to answer Question 2.4 on the revised CON29. It has been produced from records of public path orders made since October 1994 under the provisions of Sections 26, 116, 118 and 119 of the Highways Act 1980, Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The Rights of Way Section does not hold

complete records of earlier orders and orders under different legislation, information about such orders is provided if available. A copy of the plan included in the legal order can be obtained by clicking on the route and using the hyperlink next to the words Plan Link in the pop up information.
