COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2025

THE HOUSING ACT 1985 PART II SECTION 17  
AND  
THE ACQUISITION OF LAND ACT 1981

The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (in this order called the "acquiring authority") makes the following order: -

1. Subject to the provisions of this order, the acquiring authority is under section 17 of the Housing Act 1985 hereby authorised to purchase compulsorily the land described in paragraph 2 for the purpose of bringing the property back into use as a housing resource.
2. The land authorised to be purchased compulsorily under this order is the land described in the Schedule and delineated and shown outlined in red on a map prepared in duplicate, sealed with the common seal of the acquiring authority and marked "Map referred to in The City of Bradford Metropolitan District Council (194 Horton Park Avenue, Bradford, West Yorkshire BD5 ONL) Compulsory Purchase Order 2025".
