**Activity:** Raise awareness about air pollution a creative exercise. posters.

**Key Vocabulary**: Awareness, pollution, air quality.

### Warm up

- Recap what we learnt last lesson.
- What did we find out about how polluted air effects health and environment

#### **Activity**

- Did you know this before you learnt about it? Talk about how it is important to raise awareness, so others also know about pollution and importance of air quality.
- Provide poster boards, markers, and other art supplies.
- Ask each group to create a poster about air quality, including what it is, why it's important, and how to monitor it.

# **Plenary**

Share your posters with the class and display around school.
(maybe invite the parents to school and have an assembly/presentation on the

children's findings)

# **Additional Tips:**
