Title of document:	Shopfront Design Guide Supplementary Planning Document	
Subject Matter:	The Shopfront Design Guide SPD sets out best practice for the design of shopfronts, signage and security measures across the Bradford district. It will promote good design and positive change. The design principles and guidance set out in this document are applicable to the city and town centres as well as local shopping parades and other locations within the district.	
Area covered:	The SPD will apply across the full Local Authority area of the City of Bradford Metropolitan District, with the intended exception of the Saltaire World Heritage Site (WHS) due to the very special nature of that site. The Council already has a Shopfront Design Guide specific to the Saltaire WHS in place.	
Consultation period:	Representations are invited during the 4-week consultation period commencing on <b>Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November 2025</b> and concluding at <b>5pm</b> on <b>Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2025</b> .
